Hank Johnson (D) – Incumbent

Economy

- Supports taxing corporations and the wealthy to fund working-class priorities
- Helped bring in billions of dollars in federal investments for community projects, schools, transportation, small businesses, public safety, veterans, and seniors

Housing

- Supported foreclosure prevention programs, funding emergency rental assistance
