### Rich McCormick (R)– Incumbent

#### Economy

- Supports providing tax relief for middle class families, removing regulations that limit growth, and promotes entrepreneurship and innovation

#### Housing

#### Public Safety

- Supports fully funding and equipping law enforcement, and frames border security as a public safety issue

#### Education

- Opposes "radical ideologies" in schools, supports school choice and parental rights, and has called for banning federal funding for school districts that teach CRT or promote remote learning.

- Opposes any single-payer or socialized medicine proposals, favors pricing transparency, patient choice, and slashing federally mandated paperwork.

- Supports securing the border, deporting undocumented immigrants, and fully funding law enforcement to deport people who entered illegally.

### Jayson Toweh (D)

#### Economy

- Supports strengthening middle-class opportunity through "smart tax incentives, workforce investment, and affordable housing," and advocates for large-scale community investments to drive small business growth and long-term economic development

### Case Norton (D)

#### Economy

- Supports closing corporate tax loopholes, capping predatory interest rates, cracking down on corporate price-fixing, reforming grocery and rent markets, raising the minimum wage, and strengthening workers' right to organize and collectively bargain.

#### Housing

- Supports expanding affordable units, protecting tenants from predatory rent hikes, and increasing federal investment in starter homes and multi-family housing.

#### Public Safety

- Supports red flag laws with due process, improved background checks, strengthened school safety, and expanding mental health and crisis prevention resources.
- Supports funding crisis response teams as alternatives to police for non-violent mental health emergencies.

#### Education

- Supports universal Pre-K, revamping K-12 to include financial literacy, trades, tech, and civics, fully funding public schools, paying teachers a livable wage, and providing federal retention grants and housing assistance for educators in high-need districts.

#### Healthcare

- Supports Medicare for All, expanding mental health coverage and reproductive healthcare protections including abortion rights, contraception, and IVF.

#### Voting & Elections

- Supports overturning Citizens United, establishing term limits for Congress, banning or requiring real-time disclosure of congressional stock trading, and ending "backroom deals" with lobbyists.

- He supports abolishing ICE and replacing it with "a humane, constitutional immigration system" that ends mass detention and family separation, creates a permanent federal immigration ID system reflecting legal status, and provides a clear pathway to citizenship

- He opposes sending weapons and unconditional funding to governments accused of genocide or ethnic cleansing
