

U.S. House District 13

Emanuel Jones (D)

Economy

- Supports expanding access to federal grants and low-interest loans for small businesses, particularly minority- and women-owned enterprises, and wants to attract new industries in advanced manufacturing, logistics, and green energy to the district.

Housing

- As state senator, supported affordable housing initiatives to combat rising costs and prevent displacement in fast-growing areas of Georgia

Public Safety

- Supports police accountability measures and community policing
- Believes in rehabilitation programs and alternatives to incarceration, especially for first-time and juvenile offenders

Education

- Supports increased federal funding for public schools to improve teacher salaries and resources, tuition-free community college and vocational training, and expanding after-school programs, mentorship initiatives, and youth job opportunities.

Healthcare

- Supports expanding Medicaid in Georgia to cover more uninsured residents, increasing funding for hospitals and medical facilities across the district, lowering prescription drug costs, and ensuring seniors have access to affordable, high-quality healthcare.

Voting & Elections

- Has also signed the U.S. Term Limits pledge, supporting a constitutional amendment to limit congressional terms.

First Amendment

- Voted yes on HB 30 in January 2024, the bill that codified the IHRA definition of antisemitism into Georgia state law.



Jasmine Clark (D)

Economy

- Wants to make billionaires and corporations "pay their fair share," protect unions, help small businesses and entrepreneurs grow, and invest in an innovative economy for the future.

Housing

- Wants to make homeownership accessible for all as part of her broader cost-of-living agenda, and supports providing resources for veterans' housing specifically.

Public Safety

- Supports common-sense gun regulations including an assault weapons ban, criminal justice reform, and environmental justice.

Education

- Supports lowering childcare and Pre-K costs, increasing K-12 funding, protecting higher education from political attacks, safeguarding HBCUs, and investing in trades and apprenticeship programs.

Healthcare

- Supports expanding healthcare access, restoring reproductive healthcare including abortion rights and contraception, and rebuilding a world-class VA health system.

Voting & Elections

- Supports protecting the right to vote, campaign finance reform, ending partisan gerrymandering, and banning stock trading by members of Congress.

Immigration

- Opposes Trump's ICE raids

First Amendment

- Voted against Georgia HB 30, which codified the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) definition of antisemitism into state law and curtails pro-Palestine advocacy



Everton Blair Jr. (D)

Economy

- Supports a \$20 federal minimum wage indexed to inflation, increasing the earned income tax credit and connecting constituents with capital and re-skilling opportunities.

Housing

- Supports cracking down on predatory lending, renter protections, and making it easier for first-time homebuyers to buy and keep homes.
- Opposes large corporations buying up single-family homes in his district.

Public Safety

- Supports comprehensive, common-sense gun reform and frames gun violence as a public health crisis.

Education

- Believes "strong schools are the bedrock for strong communities" and that "every child should have access to quality education and career pathways no matter their zip code."

Healthcare

- Supports Medicare for All, calling healthcare a human right.

Voting & Elections

- Supports protecting the right to vote and getting "big money out of politics."

Immigration

- Has called for abolishing ICE.

First Amendment

- Is publicly opposed by AIPAC and DMFI (Democratic Majority for Israel)
- No direct statements on Palestine, BDS, or First Amendment issues related to pro-Palestinian protest were found.



Jeffrey Fautleroy Sr. (D)

Economy

- Supports policies that "support small businesses, attract new industries, and expand job opportunities."

Housing

- Supports expanding protections against "unfair rent increases and evictions, strengthening housing choice vouchers, and investing in support services for individuals facing homelessness."

Public Safety

- Wants to strengthen diversion programs, mental health services, and job training as alternatives to incarceration

Education

- Vows to "champion affordable higher education and workforce training,"

Healthcare

- Supports Medicare for All to negotiate lower prescription costs, allow coverage to continue in the event of job loss, and provide preventative care.
- Supports reducing maternal mortality and expanding services for high-risk pregnancies and post-partum care

Voting & Elections

- Has signed the U.S. Term Limits pledge, supporting a constitutional amendment to limit congressional terms.

Immigration

- Supports legislation to provide "clear pathways to citizenship and abolish ICE."

First Amendment

- Will "support legislation to recognize the genocide against Palestinians and stop arming Israel."

Heavenly Kimes (D)

Economy

- Opposes cuts to WIC, SNAP, and Medicaid, vows to "champion policies that cut red tape, expand access to capital, and invest in our community to bring good-paying jobs and economic opportunity back to the 13th District."
- Supports expanding federal grants and loan access for local entrepreneurs.

Economy

Education

- Supports restoring resources to neighborhood schools, expanding apprenticeships and technical college grants, and forgiving student debt for nurses, teachers, and first responders who serve their communities.

- Supports permanently funding Social Security and Medicare, capping prescription drug prices, and making home health services more accessible so seniors can remain independent.
- Supports directing federal health dollars toward clinics in underserved areas and pass a clean air and water package including cleanup of the South River

Economy

- Supports lowering the tax burden on working families, incentivizing small business growth and suburban job creation, and deregulation
- Supports replacing federal income, payroll, corporate, and estate taxes with a 23% national sales tax and abolishing the IRS.

Public Safety

- He frames border security as a public safety and national security issue and supports a robust military and secure borders.

Education

- Supports funding classrooms, partnering with parents, strengthening career and technical pathways, and "keeping politics out of the basics."
- Has previously supported school choice and charter schools and opposed what he describes as federal overreach in education, including critical race theory in curricula.

Healthcare

- Supports Medicaid expansion, expanding rural and telehealth access, defending patient choice, and protecting Social Security and Medicare.
